about wifi

**WiFi** enables you to connect to the internet without wires or cables.

**WiFi** is also known as 802.11b/g or Wireless LAN (WLAN). It provides fast, reliable and convenient internet access within the **WiFi** zone.

**WiFi** internet access services are similar in concept to other types of internet access and we recommend that you enable personal firewall security software or features on your devices – this is usually standard on all computers.

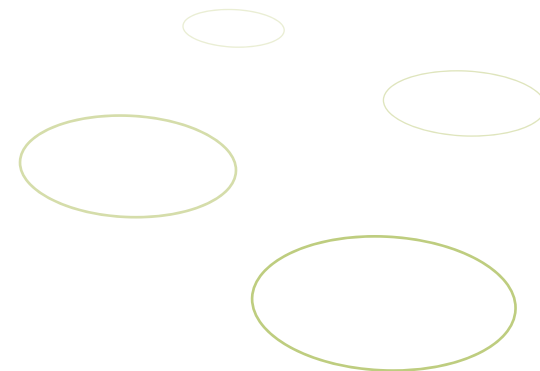

# GETTING STARTED

- 1 Turn your laptop or other **WiFi** device on. Make sure the **WiFi** is turned on (each computer is slightly different so you might need to refer to the user's guide or use the Help section in Windows or MacOS – just type in “wireless”)

Your computer will automatically find the wireless networks in the area. If the computer detects more than one (unlikely) select the **Net4** network.

- 3 Open up your Internet Explorer. The page that you would normally see will not appear, instead a **Net4** web site will appear.



If this is the first time you have used the service, you will need to register, then choose the right amount of **Net4 Time** (see plans), fill in the payment page and away you go.

When you choose a username and password, we would suggest you use your surname as your username and maybe your BIG4 membership number as your password – just so you do not forget them.
